Sealed Bids for the pre-purchase of the equipment/materials for the **WTP Electrical Upgrades** project will be received by **The City of Union**, at 101 Sharpe Avenue, Union, SC 29379, until **2:00 PM** local time on **August 17, 2023**, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The project generally consists of supplying the following equipment/material items for the project. The equipment/material prices shall include all sales taxes and shipping/delivery costs to the City of Union's Warehouse located at 405 Calhoun St., Union, SC 29379.

1. Two Motor Control Centers MCC1 and MCC2 (both 800 Amp and 480 Volt).
2. Two Enclosed Circuit Breakers MCC1 CB and MCC2 CB (both 800 Amp and 480 Volt).

Bids will be received for a single Contract or Purchase Order. Bids shall be on a unit price basis as indicated on the Bid Form.

Bidders must also make positive efforts to use small and minority-owned businesses and to offer employment, training and contracting opportunities.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 30 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Bids may be held by the Owner for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date of the opening of bids.
