Dear Ms. Pendergrass, Mr. McKissick, and Mayor Thompson:

CCA proposes to provide activities through our existent Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) Youth Leadership Program (YLP). The program will operate for 11 weeks with 6 weeks direct interaction (education/training and work experience) with students. The objective of the YLP is to enhance the student's ability to realize academic, behavioral and social achievements. The youth will learn to foster appropriate/positive relationships, develop/improve life skills and obtain work experience. CCA will utilize a case management approach to:

1. Provide character education training
2. Provide pre-employment skills training; and
3. Provide work experience placements with area community partners.

We would like to request funding from the City of Union to help with this program in the amount of \$2,070.00. This cost is based on total program participation of four students.
