1. CALL TO ORDER

2. BUSINESS

A. ORDINANCE – 1ST READING – NATURAL GAS ACQUISITION AUTHORITY

Utility Director Joe Nichols states that the Public Energy Authority of Kentucky is a Natural Gas Acquisition Authority created between and among public agencies to acquire natural gas at reasonable prices that would enhance reliability, efficiency, and supply security through the joint purchases and the arrangement of joint services on behalf of its members and other public agencies. The City desires to purchase from Seller a portion of the natural gas available to Seller under the Prepaid Agreement, and Seller desires to sell such natural gas to City of Union, upon the terms and conditions set forth herein. Our legal representatives have advised that this should be approved as an ordinance instead of by the resolution approved on May 16, 2018 by City Council. The recommendation is to approve first reading.
