Hearing To Solicit Public Comments Pertaining To A Request Made To Amend Section 109.12 – Table of Permitted Uses For Non-Residential Districts To Allow Automobile Car Washes In the A-1 District Located In The Downtown And Section 129 – Definitions Of The City Of Union Zoning Ordinance

Mayor Thompson asked if there was anyone from the general public who wish to speak regarding the above subject.

Paul Kicidis, owner of the property on 227 South Gadberry Street addressed council. He states that the property was a gas station from the 40's up through the 70's and it had a bay to wash cars. This property has been approved for tenants to have a tire shop and do detail work; however, the building is not approved to wash cars which were previously done on the property. Mr. Kicidis feels that there should not be a problem for tenants to be able to wash cars on that side of town when you already have a car wash on the other side of town. He is requesting that Section 109.12 <u>Tables of Permitted Uses for Non-Residential Districts</u> be amended to allow car washes in the A-1 District located in the downtown and Section 129 –Definitions of the City of Union Zoning Ordinance.
