1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Thompson called the meeting to order. He gave the invocation. The pledge of allegiance was given by all present. The roll was called by Municipal Clerk Gloria Rogers.

2. BUSINESS

- A. **ORDINANCE – 2ND READING** - ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UNION AMENDING, RESTATING AND ADDING PROVISION TO THE CITY’S CODE OF ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE CITY’S FORM OF GOVERNMENT AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

City Attorney Larry Flynn states the specifics of this ordinance was discussed at the June 5, 2018 meeting. He reviewed the responsibilities, powers and duties of the Mayor as outline in the ordinance and the appointment by the Mayor of Standing Committees. The ordinance passed 1st reading at the last regular meeting. He further states that the ordinance can be revised by council anytime within the State statue.

- B. **DISCUSSION/MOTION** - CAROLINA COMMUNITY ACTIONS COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT (CSCG) YOUTH LEADERSHIP PROGRAM SUMMER CAMP

Mayor Thompson states that CCA proposes to provide summer camp activities though their existent Community Services Block Grant Program (CSBG) Youth Leadership Program (YLP). CCA is requesting funding to help with the cost of the camp. Based

upon the total program participation of 4, the cost to the City of Union will be \$2,070. Staff recommends that council make a motion to fund the CCA Summer Camp Program in the amount of \$2,070.00
