



Dear Citizens,

Effective July 1, 2018, City Council approved fees for meter tampering on any of our utility meters. This means that if any meter, at any location is found to be tampered with, a tamper fee will be charged accordingly. The first offense is \$200, second offense is \$300, and the third offense may be subject to administrative civil penalties as authorized by section 6-11-285 of the code of laws of South Carolina. Once the City of Union finds that a meter has been tampered with, the City will do an investigation to determine who the party is that needs to be charged. If the City of Union cannot determine who tampered with the meter, the fee will be charged to the property owner. There will be **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Therefore, property owners, if you rent a property out please confirm that the utilities are put into the tenant's name within a timely manner.
